2019 FALL SUNDAY CAPTAIN & RETURNING PLAYER INFORMATION

League Basics

- Up to thirty-six (36) teams, depending on team sizes. We cannot guarantee we will be adding a 37th team.
- Six (6) divisions organized by level of competition. Teams will generally be placed into their divisions based on the best interest of the league as a whole. Playoffs will be split between conferences. It is unlikely all teams will make playoffs based on the size of the league.
- Games on Sundays from 11 am to 6 pm at Stead Park and Francis Field.
- Opening games 9/8. Playoffs on 11/09 and 11/01. Backup dates for playoffs are 11/16 and 11/17. No regular games scheduled on 10/7. No regular season games on Oct 27 (Rain make up week)
- Decisions concerning team status will be made by leadership beginning at the conclusion of returning player registration based on factors including number of registered players, team history, and opportunity for new teams and new captains in order to promote growth and development of the league.
- If a group doesn't achieve team status by end of registration, then players may be placed into free agent status or combined with other free agents to make team status.
- 30 maximum players per team, although teams with more than 30 players in the Spring 2019 season may carry up to that total.
- *The league waitlist will open on 8/12 after the last registration session closes.*
- Milk conference teams are expected to have at least 22 players. Due to high numbers, we will be enforcing this rule and will place players on competitive teams at the completion of registration if a team has under 22.
- All teams not in Milk Conference are expected to have at least 24 players.
- Although there is a minimum of 18 players per team, teams should be prepared to have at least 22 players.^[SEP] (Note: this does not mean that teams MUST have 22 players. If there are unassigned new players after registration, teams may be asked to pick up additional players. If this is the case, teams with fewer than 22 players will be asked first.)
- In the spirit of Stonewall, we encourage all teams to add at least 1 or 2 players who are new to the league each season.

Returning Player Registration: Monday, August 5 from 10:00AM - 8:00PM

- Returning player registration fee is \$50.00 (plus \$2.60 processing fee from Leagueapps).
- "Returning Player" = Registered and paid players, on a team, for the Spring 2018 Season of Stonewall Kickball - DC (**Sunday only**), the Sunday REMIX Summer 2019, the immediate previous season of a Stonewall Kickball league outside of Washington, D.C., or a Stonewall / DC Fray affiliated Summer 2019 League (Thursdays at Stead and Tuesday Ultra at Francis).
- Captains should review the player roster of those signing up for their team -- any corrections can be sent to dc.scores@stonewallkickball.org.
- At the end of (and during) Returning Player Registration, the Leadership Team will scrub lists against prior season rosters and will remove players not eligible to register that day.
- If a returning player does not register during "Returning Player Registration", they will pay the new player fee and register online with New Players.

Registration Process - Go to SKDC.info/ then click "Register" at the top of the page.

Helpful Steps Through the Registration System

Step 1: Go to SKDC.info and hover over "Fall 2019" at the top of the page.

Step 2: Under "Fall 2019, click "Fall 2019 Registration" from the drop down menu.

Step 3: On right side: click Register. Select appropriate option: Free Agent, Team Captain, and Team Player.

For Team Captains

Step 1: Enter Account information, or log in.

Step 2: Enter Team Name, Player Information, Read and Agree to Waiver, and Click Register for Season

Step 3: Enter Payment Information. Click Pay Securely for Registration and Go to Final Confirmation Page.

For Team Players

Step 1: Enter Account Information, or log in.

Step 2: Select Team (Note: Team Captain must create team before players register for it).

Step 3: Enter Player Information, read and agree to waiver. Click Register for Season

Step 4: Enter Payment Information. Click Pay Securely for Registration and Go to Final Confirmation Page.

Friends Registration: Opens August 14 at 10AM

- Friends Registration Fee is \$25.00 (plus \$2.60 processing fee from Leagueapps).
- May register as a Friend of SKDC or a Friend of a specific team.
- Entitled to selected player benefits (e.g., sponsor discounts, open bar at the closing party).

Free Agent Selection

- Free Agent Social: Tuesday, August 13 at 7-9PM at The Dirty Goose
- Captains wishing to select free agents may send their selections before the free agent social to dc.scores@stonewallkickball.org or can select players at the free agent social.
- For any free agent not selected at the Free Agent Social, the Leadership Team will work to have them placed on a team; however, free agents should recognize that *it is primarily **their** responsibility to join a team*. If in the unlikely event the Leadership Team is unable to place a free agent, the free agent's registration fee will be refunded.
