2022 FALL SUNDAY CAPTAIN & RETURNING PLAYER GUIDE

League Basics

- Up to forty (40) teams, depending on team sizes and registration trends.
- Three (3) conferences, broken down into divisions and organized by level of competition. Teams will generally be placed into their divisions based on the best interest of the league as a whole. Playoffs will be split between conferences, with all teams playing in playoffs.
- Games on Sundays from 11 am to 6 pm and Stead Park, Shaw Park, and the National Mall.
- Season Schedule:
 - Opening games: 9/11
 - Playoffs: 11/12 and 11/13
 - Backup dates for playoffs: 11/19 and 11/20
- Decisions concerning team status will be made by Leadership beginning at the conclusion of returning player registration based on factors including number of registered players, team history, and opportunity for new teams and new captains in order to promote growth and development of the league.
- If a group doesn't achieve team status by end of registration, then players may be placed into free agent status or combined with other free agents to make team status.
- 30 players maximum per team, except where otherwise negotiated with the Leadership Team.
- The league waitlist will open on 8/2 after the last registration period closes.
- Milk Conference, Division A teams are required to have at least 15 players. Milk Conference, Division B and C teams are required to have at least 20 players.
- Rivera and Johnson Conference teams are required to have at least 24 players, unless an exemption is granted from the Leadership Team.
- In the spirit of Stonewall, we encourage all teams to add at least 1 or 2 players who are new to the league each season.
- **Returning Player Registration: Thursday, July 28 from 10 am – 8 pm (Online)**
- Returning player registration fee is \$55.00 (plus \$2.90 processing fee from LeagueApps).

- “Returning Player” = Registered, paid, and on a team for the Spring 2022 season of Stonewall Kickball – DC
- Captains should review the player roster of those signing up for their team. Any corrections can be sent to skdc.technical@stonewallsports.org.
- At the end of (and during) Returning Player Registration, the Leadership Team will scrub lists against prior season rosters and will remove players not eligible to register that day.
- If a returning player does not register during “Returning Player Registration,” they will pay the new player fee and register online with New Players.
- Social Chair Mixer date will be announced when the date and time is finalized.

Registration Process

Helpful Steps Through the Registration System

Tip: If possible, complete registration on a laptop or desktop to reduce risk of system rejection during the payment process.

Step 1: Go to SKDC.info and hover over “League Play” at the top of the page.

Step 2: Under “League Play,” click “Fall 2022 Registration” from the drop down menu.

Step 3: On right side, click “Register,” and select your designation: “Free Agent,” “Team Player,” or “Team Captain.”

For Team Captains

Step 1: Create or log into account.

Step 2: Enter team name, answer registration questions, read and agree to the waiver, and click “Register for Season.”

Step 3: Enter payment information, making sure to click to submit. (Note: If your payment is rejected, ensure your billing address is entered correctly or try another card.)

For Team Players

Step 1: Enter Account Information, or log in.

Step 2: Select Team (Note: Team Captain must create team before team players register for it).

Step 3: Answer registration questions, then read and agree to waiver. Click “Register for Season.”

Step 4: Enter payment information, making sure to click to submit. (Note: If your payment is rejected, ensure your billing address is entered correctly or try another card.)

Friends Of Registration: Saturday, Jan. 29th from 10 am – 8 pm (Online)

- Friends Of Registration Fee is \$30.00 (plus \$2.90 processing fee from LeagueApps).
- May register as a Friend Of any specific team.

- Entitled to select player benefits (e.g., sponsor discounts, open bar at the closing party).

Free Agent Selection

- Captains wishing to select free agents may send their selections before the free agent social to skdc.technical@stonewallsports.org or may select players at the free agent social event.
- For any free agent not selected at the Free Agent Social, the Leadership Team will work to have them placed on a team; however, free agents should recognize that *it is primarily **their** responsibility to join a team*. In the unlikely event the Leadership Team is unable to place a free agent, the free agent's registration fee will be refunded.
